Under this consultancy, the Individual Consultant (IC) will design, develop and complete a data document system that will involve matrices of standardized datasets on various population dynamics and reproductive health indicators that are age- and sex-disaggregated and are geographically broken down up to the barangay level.	
	The datasets will serve as UNFPA's contribution to OCHA's Common Operational Datasets (CODs) for the Philippines that will be regularly published and used as baseline for all operational data and information products during humanitarian situations. The Common Operational Datasets represent the best-available datasets on various subjects and are the de-facto standard for data and information needed to design and implement humanitarian response by all actors.
